



### **2007 Scholarship Eligibility Requirements**

1. Full-time applicants must have completed a minimum of twelve (12) semester hours in Management Information Systems (MIS) and/or Computer Science courses and be currently enrolled in twelve (12) or more semester hours.
2. Part-time applicants must have completed a minimum of twelve (12) semester hours in Management Information Systems (MIS) and/or Computer Science courses and be currently enrolled in no more than eleven (11) semester hours.
3. Four-year university applicants must be in their junior or senior year; two-year associate applicants must be within two (2) semesters of graduation
4. Applicants must have an overall G. P. A. of 2.75 and a G. P. A. of at least 3.0 in their major. The scholarship committee will only consider courses taken within the last 10 years when calculating overall G. P. A. unless prior grades would help the G. P. A.
5. There will be no discrimination on the basis of age, sex, race, color, national origin or religious affiliation.
6. The scholarships will be awarded to individuals who are pursuing a career in Management Information Systems (MIS) or Computer Science (CS) related fields and who, in the judgment of the committee, are capable of achieving excellence as professionals in these fields. Judgment will be based on scholarship applications, the content of the applicant's cover letter and personal interviews.
7. Students who are chosen as recipients of scholarships will be provided with a monetary award and a one-year ASM Tulsa student membership.
8. To meet IRS guidelines, students will need to provide a receipt, or letter from their college or university, reflecting that they have paid tuition or other education expenses equal to at least the amount of the scholarship they receive from ASM Tulsa. Students must also provide their social security number.
9. Students will be actively recruited from colleges and universities in the Tulsa area. Any student who attends an Oklahoma college or university may apply for a scholarship provided they would be available for an interview in Tulsa.
10. No members of the scholarship selection committee or their relatives will be eligible to receive these scholarships.
